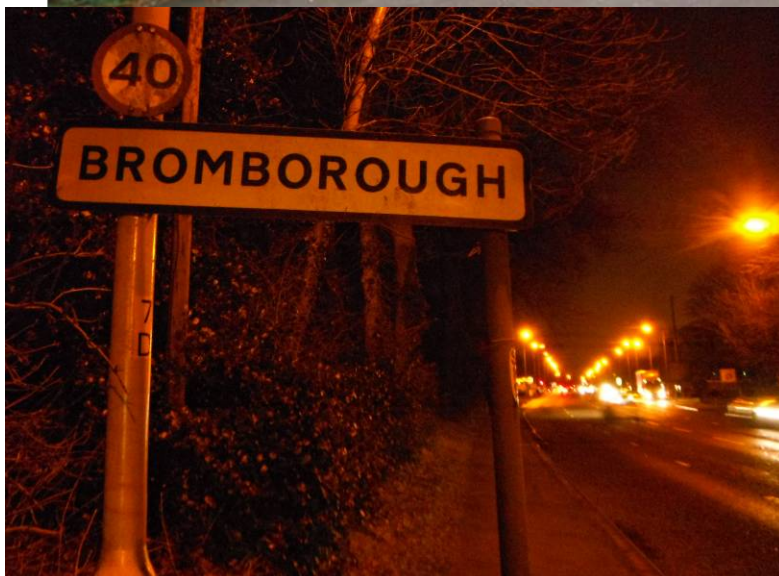

Down to the



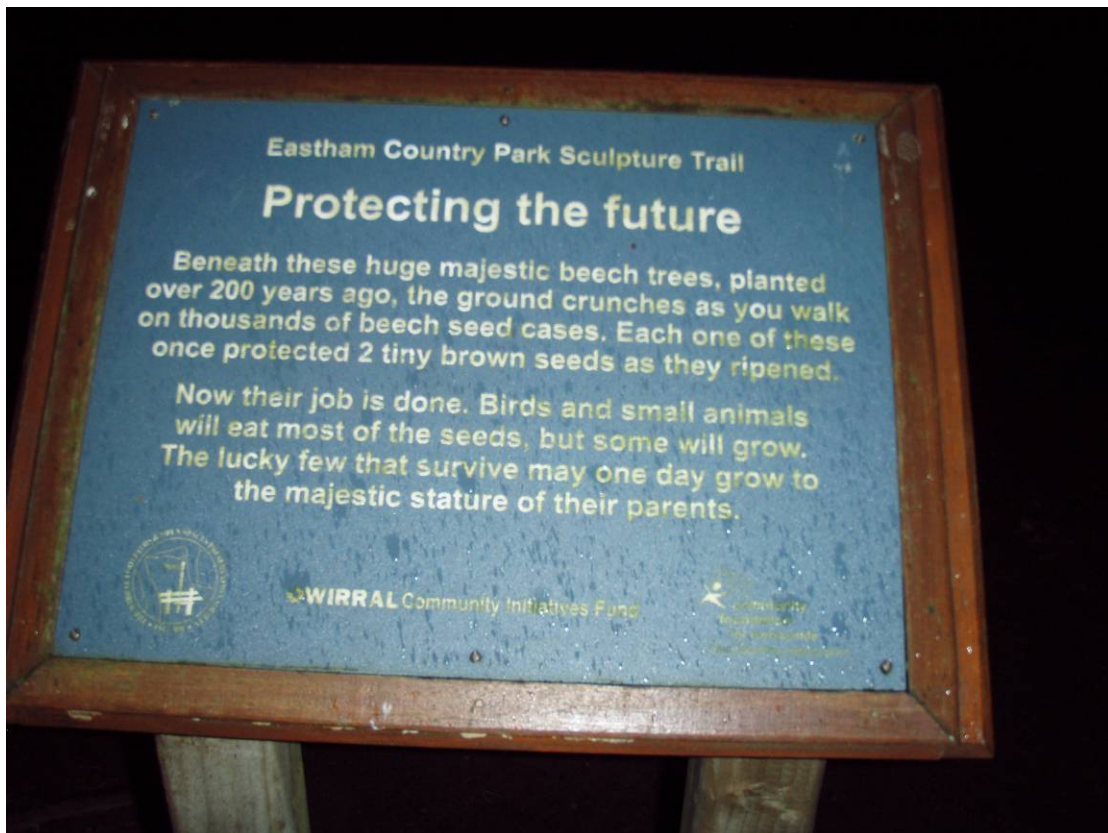
Where a certain amount of standing around took place.

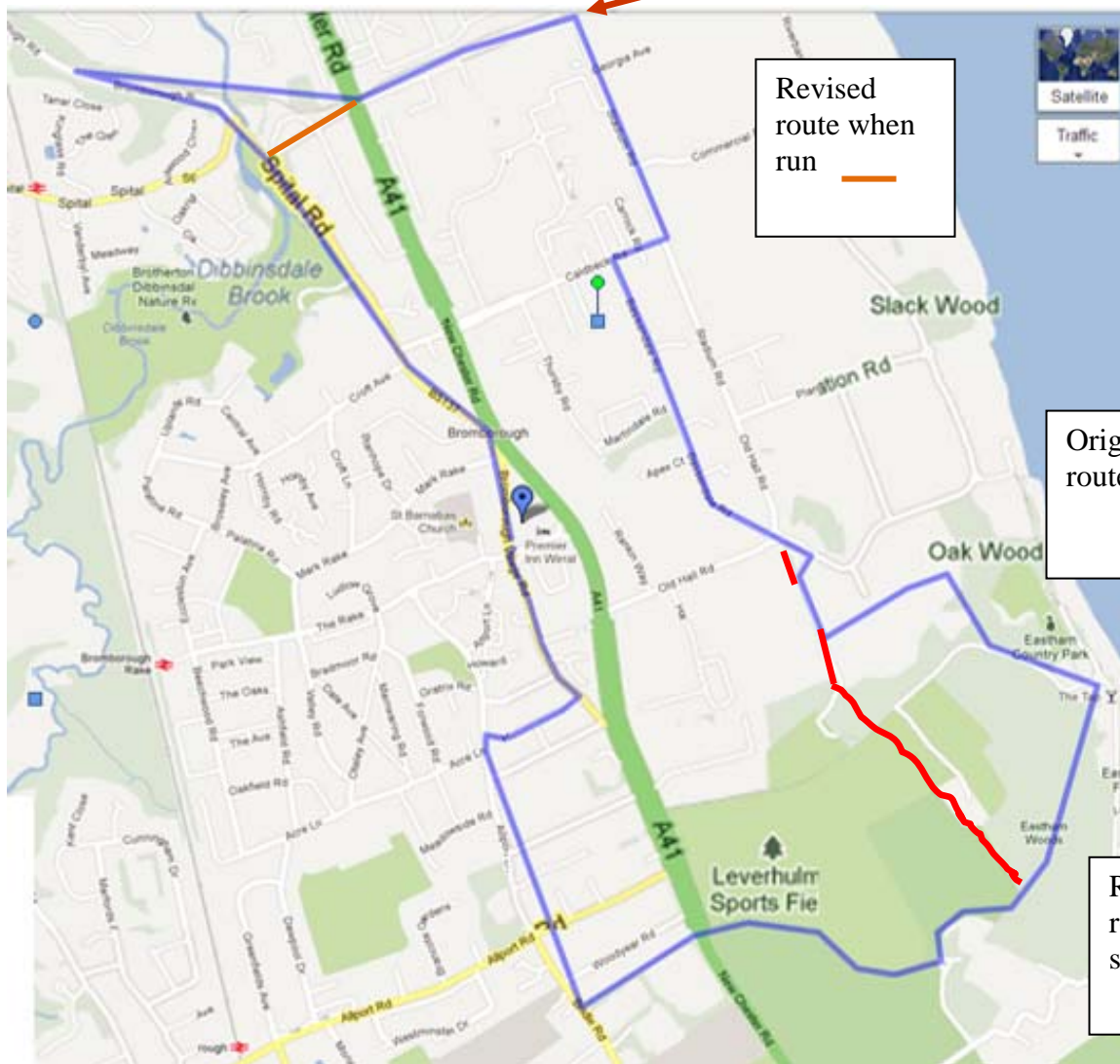
