Cross Member's cross member

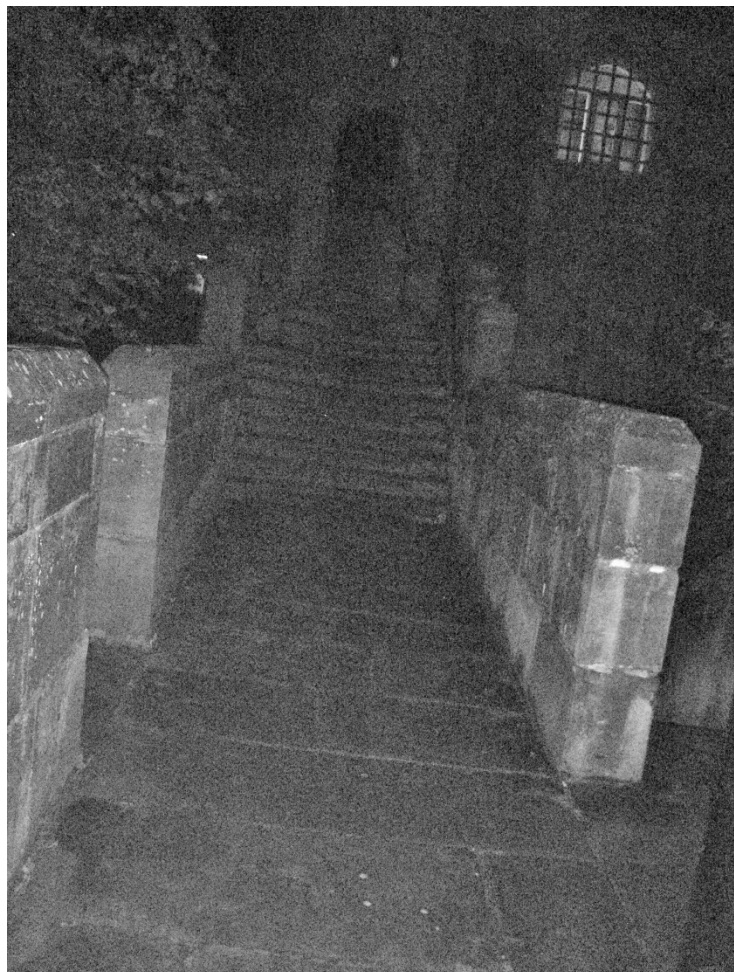


Over we went and down to the meadow
