And 10secs was on Brewdog

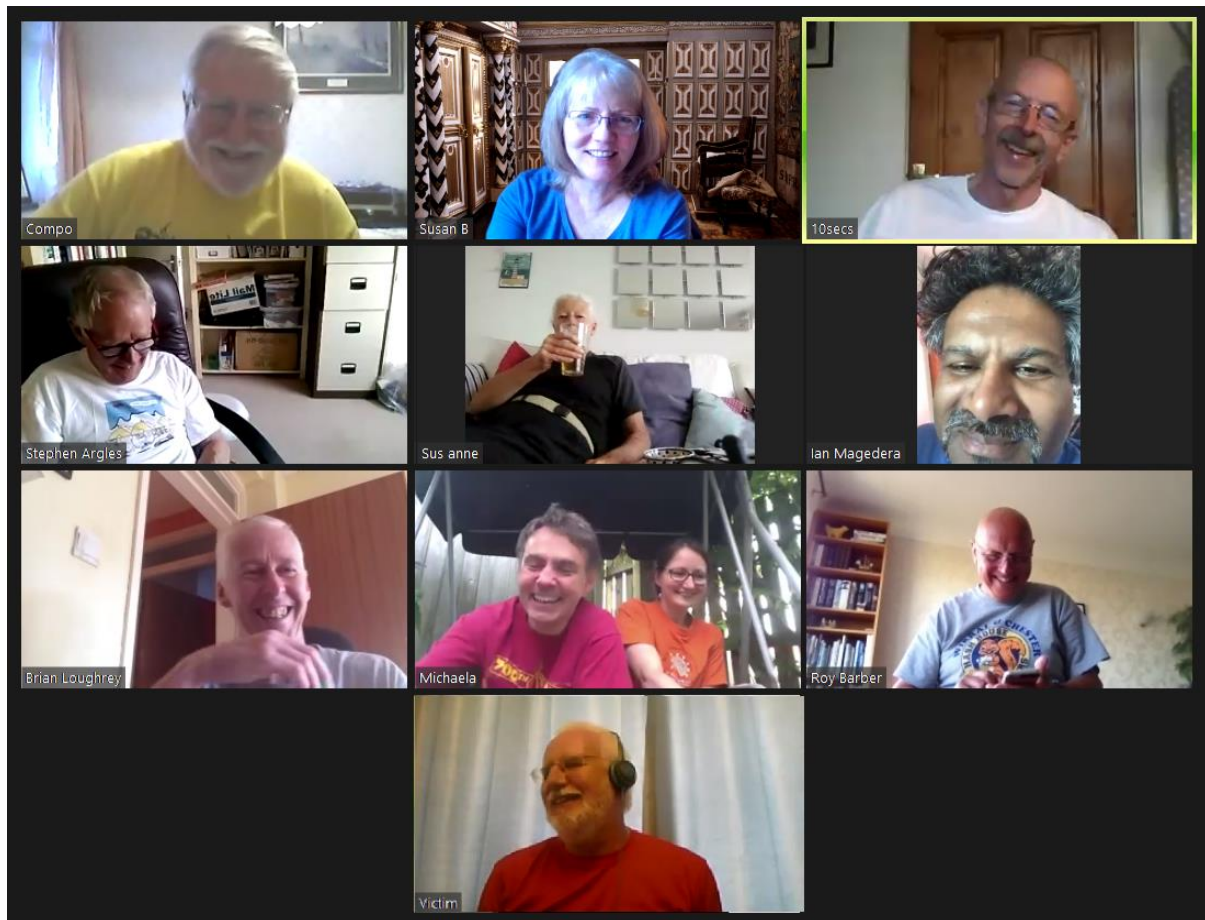

Eccles for having a halo



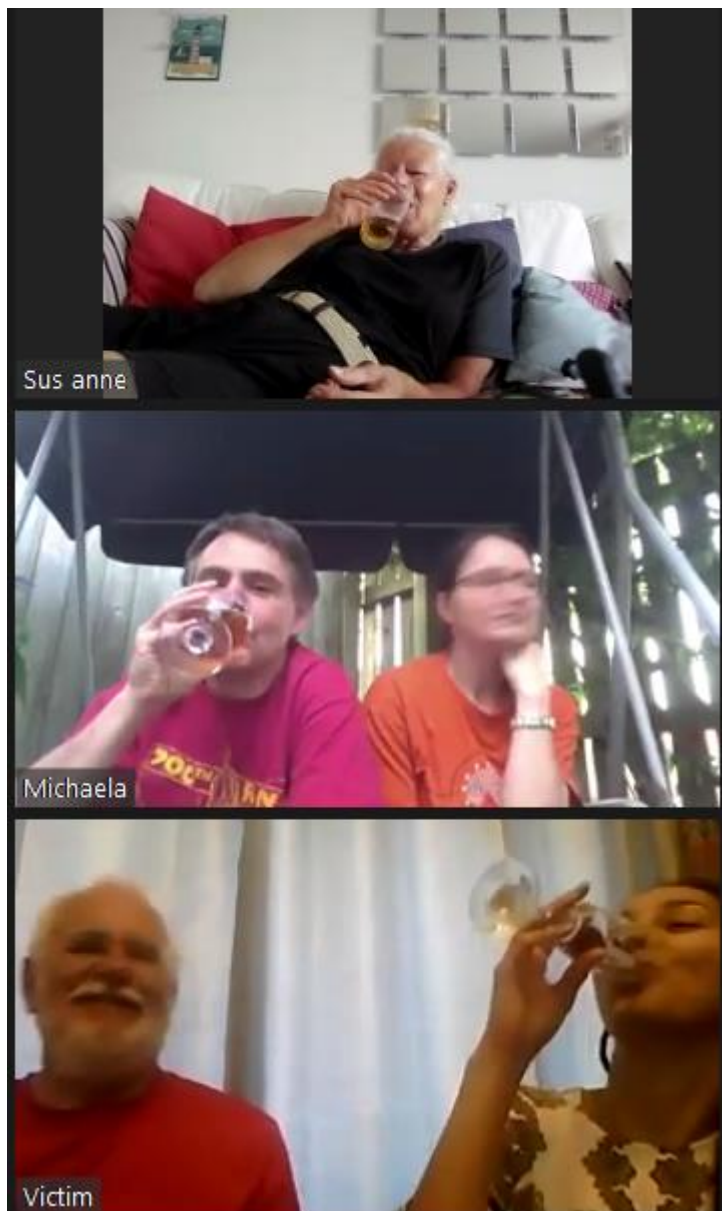
FC & Bimbo for wining:
