
The Pack: SF and Glad Rags (Hares), Snoozanne, Mad Hatter, 10secs, OTT, ET fcuk

of the pack – there could be anything up to three blobs but you were not on until you found an arrow. The blobs when found turned out to be large chalk drawings rather than lumps of flour.










Eventually we emerged back on Riverside Drive, near where a fair was set up on the open ground; looking rather creepy as fairs tend to do when not in operation.



You said there'd be a chippy!





