

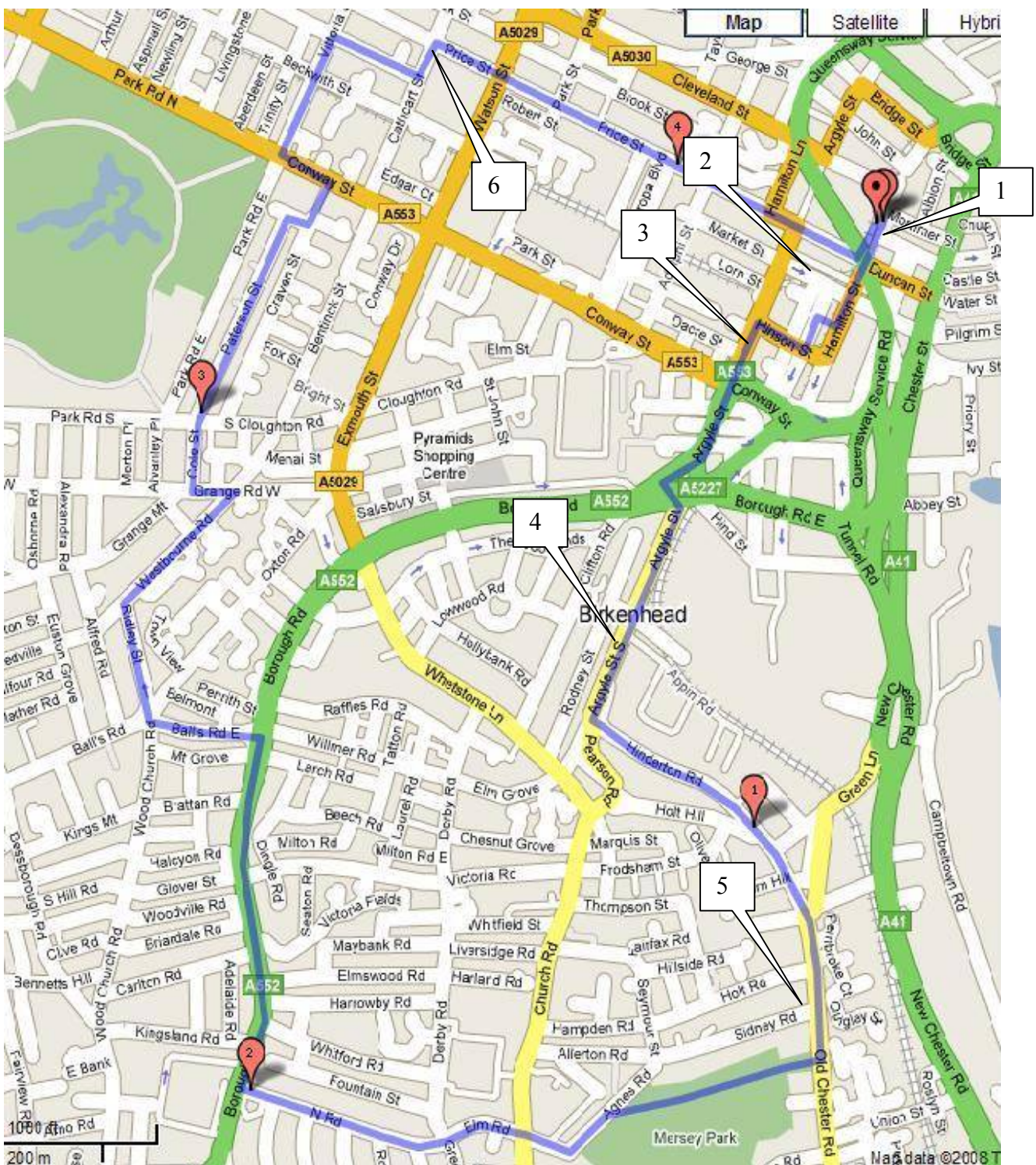


# MERSEY THIRSTDAYS HASH HOUSE HARRIERS
